An award application consists of:

1. Name of the award
2. Name of the Club
3. A paragraph about the project/activity telling what, where, when, how, why and who.

1. Arbor Day Project Award

- a. Club completing an Arbor Day project.

2. Civic Improvement Award

- a. Best project that make the earth more valuable for all living creatures.

3. Civic Development Award

- a. Best project that grows and evolves over a year to become more complete and desirable to the community.

4. Civic Beautification Award

- a. Best project that delights the senses and/or exalts the mind and adds value to human existence.

5. Community Project Award

- a. Best project that enhances the community and/or its residents.

6. Artistic Craft Award

- a. One or more artistic craft workshops for membership.
- b. Club sponsored demonstration/workshop for youth groups.
- c. Clubs working with senior citizens and senior facilities.

7. Conservation Award

- a. Club completing an educational program on conservation and/or a conservation project.

8. Environmental Education Award

- a. Club presenting a program to educate its members and/or the public about some environmental issue of concern.

9. Environmental Project/Action Award

- a. Club completing an environmental project or taking a course of action on an environmental issue or concern.

10. Flower Show Award

- a. Club presenting A Stand Flower Show during the year.

11. Mary Ruggles Scholarship Participation Award

- a. Club contributing \$25 or more in the year

12. Membership Award

- a. Greatest percentage of membership increase.
- b. Greatest overall membership increase.

13. Native Plant Award

- a. Educational program of project competed on native plants and their uses.

14. Program Award

- a. A single program that:
 - i. Stimulates interest in gardening.
 - ii. Is presented at a single meeting by one or more persons.
 - iii. Is adaptable for presentation to other Clubs.

15. Scholarship Award

- a. Clubs donating \$25 or more to the WSFGC Scholarship Fund or any other scholarship.

16. Recycling Award

- a. Club completing a recycling project.

17. Club Website Award

- a. Club creating an interesting and informative website for its members and the general public.

18. Youth Education/Involvement Award

- a. Best youth educational program or project presented by a Club.

19. Yearbook/Newsletter Award

- a. Completion of a Club yearbook or newsletter

An award application consists of:

1. Name of the award
2. Name of the member being nominated
3. Name of the Club the member belongs to
4. A paragraph telling why this person should be considered for the award.

Selection shall be made by the District Awards Committee Chairperson and the District Officers.

1. Margaret Anderson Community Project Award

- a. Member who performs an outstanding leadership role in organizing, planning and implementing a club or district community project.

2. Elizabeth Timmer Landscape Design Award

- a. Member who shares knowledge of landscape design with others through workshops, published articles and presentations.
- b. Member who completes a landscape design using the principles and elements of design and shares it with is others so it becomes an educational experience.

3. Cora Zoberst Horticulture Award

- a. Member winning the greatest number of blue ribbons during the year in the horticulture division of Club, District and WSFGC Stand Flower Shows.

4. Joyce Johnson Floral Design Award

- a. Member winning the greatest number of blue ribbons during the year in the design division of Club, District and WSFGC Stand Flower Shows.

5. Inez Morach Educational Award

- a. Member with the best Educational Exhibit in a Club, District or WSFGC Standard Flower Show.

6. Iola Ratcliff Award of Service

- a. Member giving outstanding service to Chuckanut District through support of the organization, activities, projects and events by giving outstanding personal time and effort.

- a.
