Projects for 2011 - 2012

1. Project: Hal Ramaley Park.

Activity

Adoption of Hal Ramaley Park under Oak Harbor's "Adopt a Park" program

2. Project: Oak Harbor Downtown Revitalization

Activities:

3. Project: Hold a Standard Flower Show in 2012

Activities:

5. Project: Youth gardening project at Oak Harbor Hillcrest Elementary 2011-20113

Activities

Teachers and students develop and maintain a school garden, planting edibles and flowers in a hands-on curriculum, to educate and beautify.

6. Project: Garden Tour and Tea held in spring 2011 -2012

Activities

6 to 7 local gardens open to the public with our club members serving as hostesses for a fun day of enjoying and sharing . One garden is chosen as the tea garden and Refreshments are served.
