

TVG Minutes  
April 5, 2016

Kris presented information about a speaker who does mosaics. It was agreed that this would be an interesting topic for a future club meeting.

Marisa announced that the speaker for the May meeting will be the lady who does floral design and who had been scheduled earlier in the year but could not come. Members are to bring containers and flowers from their yards.

TVG members will be participating in the Haggen planting day on April 23. Members signed up for various shifts, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

It was agreed that we will have a field trip to the Maltby Café and Flower World on May 19, and to SortiCulture, in Everett, on June 10. Plan to leave the south Park & Ride at 8:00 a.m.

The business meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m. and Gerry Douglas demonstrated how to sharpen pruning tools.
