

## TVG Minutes for August 2016

Tulip Valley Gardeners met on August 2, at the home of Gerry Douglas. Those present were: Daphne Ruxton, Kathy Hansen, Sandy Randles, Marisa Earnst, Gerry Douglas and Cherie Cobby

Marisa called the business meeting to order at about 6:30. The minutes of the July meeting were read and approved. Gerry Douglas gave an informal treasurer's report. The balance in TVG's bank account is currently 2,643.31. Of this, \$830 is donations to the Emma Jarvis Garden, \$659.56 is from the garage sale, and \$50 is dues. Cherie turned in another \$40 from sale of plants.

Gerry proposed that TVG open a savings account for a Skagit Community Foundation to provide funds to maintain the Emma Jarvis Garden. This was seconded and carried.

There was discussion of possibly having a sale of garden art and tools in during Tulip Festival next April. No definite plans as yet.

Daphne announced that the next Spring Soiree will be April 28, (last Friday in April). The speaker will be from WSFGC. The site is to be determined.

There was discussion of the wreath sale. Daphne has a big supply of bows that she is offering for us to use, so we may not have to make more this year.

Cherie has asked for help in transferring plants, donated for the TVG fall plant sale, from her neighbor's yard. There were volunteers offering assistance.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 7:30, and there was further discussion of the fall plant sale.
